Admission

- Tickets must be purchased in advance
- Staff will be waiting in the Blue Parking lot next to the solar panels beside Grisham Pavilion.

Tent Location

- All guests are required to assemble their own tents
- Please set up your tent, socially distancing yourself from other groups

Health and Safety

- **Per Garden policy guests will be required to wear masks when unable to maintain a safe social distance**
 - Required mask areas:
 - Picking up food
 - Restrooms
 - A sanitation station will be setup between the bathroom doors and will include the following:
 - Hand sanitizer
 - Paper towels
 - Bottle of cleaner (Staff use)
 - Bathrooms will be cleaned and wiped down every hour

Food

- Dinner: Chick-fil-A
 - Please send 1-2 family members to retrieve your boxed meals (2 if larger family)
 - Employees will be wearing appropriate PPE to administer food
 - Each family will also receive a pan of Jiffy Pop
 - Tables will be wiped down each time guests have finished using them; all placed in a social distance manner
- Breakfast
 - Similar routine as dinner
 - Options: Packaged muffins or breakfast bars; Coffee, juice boxes



Garden Hikes/Story Time

- Upon arrival, a rotating schedule will be provided to minimize group size and spread out fire pit use to provide the safest environment possible
- Story time will be led by staff at the end of the night, post hike
