Celebrate nature's beauty at butterfly release hosted by Huntsville Botanical Garden

HUNTSVILLE, Ala. (May 8, 2023) – Flutter on over to Huntsville Botanical Garden (HBG) to celebrate one of nature's most beautiful creatures. Butterflies return to the Purdy Butterfly House at HBG at the first two butterfly releases of the year on May 13 at 10 a.m. and 11 a.m.

Guests of all ages will enjoy sharing in the magic of safely releasing live butterflies into the Purdy Butterfly House, which re-opens on May 13 after being closed for maintenance. The program begins with a brief presentation about butterflies and their habitat, followed by the safe restoration of the Garden's indoor butterfly population.

Butterfly releases take place throughout the summer, and each program lasts approximately 30 minutes. Registration is required and space is limited. Butterfly releases are \$8 per person, in addition to Garden admission for non-members.

Additional butterfly releases are scheduled for 10 a.m. and 11 a.m. on each of the following days:

- August 12
- August 26
- September 2
- September 16
